Dylan: I will always hear your sweet voice singing the Schoolhouse Rock songs.

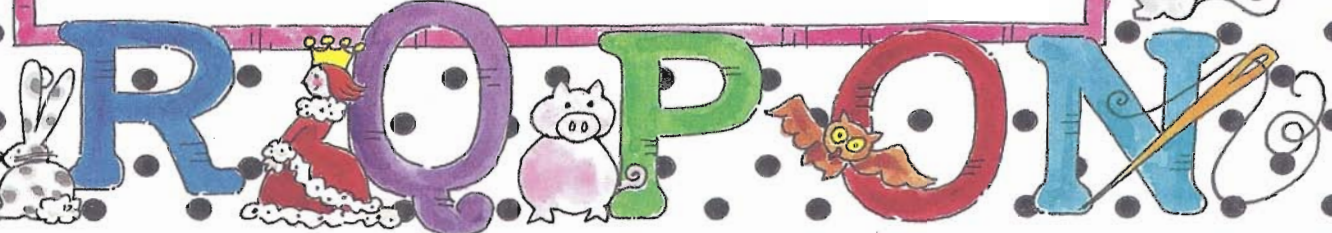
Eric: I will remember your sweet smile and your funny giggle.
